Description

We will have time to make 3 different kinds of journals or books.

Fabric journal

This can be quite meditative to make for first thing on Monday morning. ☺

Made of fabric that is plain, printed, previously embellished, etc.

Will take 1 hour to make, depending on how much embellishing you add.

There are examples below.



File Folder

A medium sized journal made with a decorated file folder or a small journal made using the sides of a tissue box. This journal is simple but will give you a feel for the process of making a hand-made book/journal. This is made of easily accessible supplies. The cover can be decorated as you like. You can use all kinds of paper to make this will take about 2 hours to make, depending on the amount of embellishment you wish to add. The example attached is decorated with washi tape, but any kind of mixed media embellishment is possible and will be fun to make.



Mixed Media

The third kind of journal is mostly about creating a fun paper-fabric cover using paper such as old pages, napkins, tissue paper, or fabric snippets on a fabric base.

The first exhibition of the Fate, Destiny and Self Determination was at Craft Ontario in Toronto in September 2014, thanks to Janna Hiemstra. Almost exactly ten years later, thanks to the Biennale Internationale du lin de Portneuf (Adrien Landry and Laurie Beland in particular) the installation will be part of the opening reception ceremonies in Guimaraes, Portugal as part of the Contextile 2024 textile art event, opening September 7, 2024 and closing December 15 2024. The exact location of the venue will be known in August, though we do know that it will be one of these three museums, all exhibiting textile art by artists juried into the event.

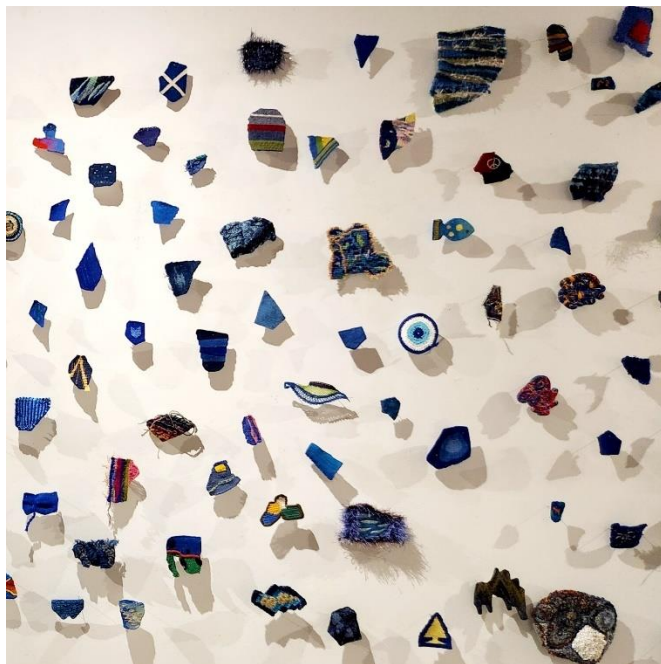
